

COVINGTON 175TH CELEBRATION CONCESSION CONTRACT INFORMATION

1. All food vendors are responsible for obtaining a permit from the Miami County Health Department.

2. Items listed on the contract are subject to approval. After approval, there will be no changes unless you contact us for approval.

3. All soft drink containers in cans will not exceed 12 ounces and will be priced at \$1.00. There will be no glass containers allowed. The cost of fountain drinks will be determined by the vendor.

4. Bottled water containers will not exceed 16.9 ounces and will be priced at \$1.00.

5. Coffee containers will not exceed 8 ounces and will be priced at \$.75.

6. Food vendors will furnish their own covering to protect their concession area from contamination, rain, dust, etc.

7. A small \$25.00 fee will be charged to vendors needing electricity.

8. All booths are responsible for their own lights, heavy-duty extension cords, and adapters.

9. Set-up will begin at 8:00 a.m. on Friday, July 9, 2010. Security for the area will begin at noon Friday and end at 7:00 P.M. Sunday evening.

Final dismantling must take place by noon Monday, July 12.

10. Booths are required to be open the following minimum times:

4 P.M. – 9 P.M. Friday, July 9

11 A.M. – 9 P.M. Saturday, July 10

Noon – 6 P.M. Sunday, July 11

11. Vendors are responsible for the proper clean up of their booth space and surrounding area. Failure to keep the area clean will result in an additional fee.

12. Any organization not adhering to the above rules will be asked to leave.

13. Locations will be determined by the festival committee.

14. The entry form must be completed and returned by June 10, 2010.
